

Ottawa-Glandorf Baseball Team Has New Field General

Stan Myer's First Season at Ottawa-Glandorf

The Ottawa-Glandorf baseball team has a new coach this season, but one that should be very familiar with the Titan players.

Stan Myers will be in his first year as head coach of Ottawa-Glandorf, but he has 14 years of coaching Titan teams. You see Myers has been coaching the O-G Acme team for 14 years so he is very familiar with the players and past history of the team.

Myers comes into the O-G system having two years head varsity experience at Allen East (where he was 22-19), five years of junior varsity experience, a year as an O-G baseball assistant, one year as O-G's softball coach and 14 years of coaching the O-G Acme.

Assisting him this season will be Tom VonSossan, with Dave Kersh and Steve Unterbrink as volunteer assistants.

His first team at O-G will be very young as there are only six lettermen on the roster. However they combine

for 13 years of varsity baseball experience.

Seniors Todd Leatherman, Steve Kersh and Brad Schomaeker all have earned three varsity letters, while senior Brent Nienberg has two varsity letters. The other two letter winners are junior Eric Dunn and sophomore Lee Flores.

Pitching could be an asset for the team as Schomaeker, Leatherman, Dunn and Flores all have experience. Assisting them behind the plate will be another three years letter winner in Kersh, so the Titans would seem to have a very experienced battery group.

The remainder of the lineup could also prove to be a factor. Despite not having a lot of varsity experience they have played together over the summer and picked up some experience as a unit. They were scheduled to start the season Saturday with Paulding. Thursday, weather permitting they will host Miller City in a home contest.
