

Vikings Overcome Early Deficit to Defeat Rockets

Henry Achieves 400th Career Win

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PANDORA – Leipsic overcame an early deficit Monday to defeat Pandora-Gilboa 15-6 in Blanchard Valley Conference action.

The game only went five innings after a delay in the top of the third inning before darkness set in the fifth inning.

The win for Leipsic was the 400th career coaching win for head coach Darren Henry.

The Rockets took a 2-0 lead in the first inning on a two-run home run by Cory Gerten. The Vikings bounced back in the top of the second as they scored four times as Lane Viera had an RBI single before Avery Paris had a bases loaded double scoring three runs.

Leipsic took control of the game in the top of the third inning as they scored seven times. The Rockets answered back with four runs in the bottom of the inning before the Vikings scored three times in the fourth and once in the fifth.

Julian Zuniga picked up the win working 2 1/3 innings before Colin Niese came on to close out the win.

Paris had a double while driving in five runs for Leipsic, John Dewar had two doubles and a single, while Aaron Hazelton and Niese both had two hits with an RBI. Viera had a hit with three RBI.

Nolan Leatherman suffered the loss for the Rockets working 2 1/3 innings.
