Vaughnsville, Continental and High Ottoville School basketball teams will represent Putnam County in District Class B basketball tournament which will open in the Leipsic gymnasium tonight, Thursday, and which will continue on Friday and Saturday evening of this week and on Wednesday, Friday and Saturday evenings of next week.

Vaughnsville won its second consecutive county championship Saturday evening by defeating the Continental team 50 to 35 in the tournament finals.

In the consolation finals, Ottoville won over Columbus Grove, 35 t 32, to secure the third-place honors in the county program.

Vaughnsville started out in whirl-wind fashion Saturday evening and by the end of the first quarter had their opponents in check by a score of 14 to 5.

Continental came back strong in the second quarter, however, and, by half time, Vaughnsville's lead was cut to four points, 24 to 20.

The champion team connected for 17 points in the third period to six for the runner-up quintette and both teams played on an even basis with nine each in the final period.

Vaughnsville's big 6'6" Sylvester Goedde, controlled the rebounds, getting nine of his 11 buckets on tip-ins and leading both teams in scoring with 27.
