

VAUGHNSVILLE TAKES HONORS GROVE SECOND

Continental Beats Ottawa Parochial Five SECTIONAL TOURNEY

Three County Teams to be Included

Vaughnsville High's basketball team walked away with high honors in the Putnam high tournament finals at Leipsic Saturday and was awarded the crown for the third consecutive year. Columbus Grove came in second with Continental third.

Ottawa Parochial was sent to the bench in the final game of the consolation bracket Saturday evening by the Continental team and, as a result, will not have a part in the Sectional tournament which opens this Thursday evening at Leipsic.

Saturday evening Continental and Parochial took the floor for the second game of the tournament and the final event to decide the consolation honors. The Monroe Township boys won by a score of 41 to 31. Continental took immediate possession of the lead and at half-time was leading 18 to 10.

In the final contest, Grove started with a determination to upset the dope bucket and by the end of the first quarter had the county tourney

winner down by a count of 17 to 11. Vaughnsville came into its own in the next period with Goedde finding the basket and running the score to 27 to 24 in favor of Vaughnsville at the half.

Vaughnsville added twelve points in the third quarter with the period ending 39 to 32. Both teams scored eleven points in the final period.

Goedde made 27 points in the game and brought his total for the tournament to 122. Goedde is credited with having the highest average score in the state for high school players for the season.
