

Miller City Wins Title in County Basketball Tourney

Beat Continental in Finals 43-32

Continental News Review – February 25, 1950

Miller City High School's basketball team walked off with the county tournament honors Saturday night when they beat Continental in the finals 43-32. It was the 22nd consecutive victory of the season for the champions without a loss.

The championship game was a fairly well cut and dried affair after the first two minutes. Continental took the initial lead but the Millers took over 6-4 and after that were never headed. Miller City held quarter leads of 12-5, 20-8, 33-14 and 43-32.

Continental turned on the pressure in the last quarter but were too far behind to cause much trouble for the high-flying Wildcats. Frank Schroeder of Miller City paced the scoring with 13 points. Kirkendall led Continental with 11 points, nine of them coming in the last quarter.

In the consolation game for third place Ottoville won a thriller from Leipsic 38-34 in what was the best game of the tournament.

Miller City, Continental and Ottoville will represent the county in the district tourney at Defiance which opened Wednesday night.
