History of the Basketball Gymnasium for Ottawa High School 1962 – 1964

In 1962, the high schools of Ottawa Public and Ottawa Saints Peter and Paul consolidated to become the Ottawa Lancers. In 1965, this school then consolidated with Glandorf High School to become the Ottawa-Glandorf High School.

The Ottawa Lancer's first and only gym was the same gym that both schools had been playing in, the Fourth Street Gym.

This gym was used by both schools when they played their first home game on November 17, 1939.

Ottawa High School lasted only three years. It consolidated with Glandorf 1965.

The floor dimensions were $47 \ge 74$. It had bleacher seats on one side and a stage with bleachers on the other. It had a seating capacity of at least 700.
