The Ft. Jennings alumni got off to a fast start in a game against the varsity last Friday night, but ran out of gas in the second quarter and the Musketeers downed the grads 50-44 for the first win of the season.

The alumni led 13-6 after the first eight minutes but the varsity out pointed them 18-8 in the second stanza for a 24-21 halftime lead and they held on during the last two periods.
