

# Columbus Grove Girl's Tournament Champions

The girls' teams of the county fought through the semi-finals in connection with the regular county tournament. The result being that Columbus Grove and Vaughnsville were left to battle for county honors. The two schools arranged for the meet at Leipsic Tuesday.

The Grove team went through the season undefeated and was awarded with a cup of honor as a mark of distinction for the county championship. The champion five had little trouble with their contenders and led in the scoring all the way.
