## Odds of Winning are Quoted

As the Putnam County Fourteenth Annual Tournament gets into action this week, we'll try to give you a little of the inside dope as to facts, figures, guesses, hopes, wishes and I told you so.

In girls overtime games there will be a rest of three minutes followed by one overtime period of three minutes. If a tie still exists, each player of the competing teams will be allowed one free throw, the team making the most free throws will be declared the winner.

In boys overtime games, the first team to score two points in the overtime period or periods is to be declared the winner.

If we were Jack Doyle, here's how we would quote the odds on the winner of both tournaments, taking into consideration the drawing.

Girls – Leipsic 3-1; Crawfis 2-1; Ottawa 5-1; Vaughnsville 8-1; Continental 10-1; Columbus Grove 15-1; Miller City, Glandorf, Kalida 25-1.

Boys – Ottoville 3-1; Columbus Grove 5-1; Leipsic 5-1; Vaughnsville 7-1; Crawfis 10-1; Ottawa Parochial 10-1; Pandora 12-1; Continental 15-1; Ottawa Public 17-1; Miller City, Glandorf, Kalida 25-1.

On Saturday night of this week these probable scraps should give any rooter action. Ottoville and Vaughnsville and Columbus Grove and Leipsic, out of these four teams, will emerge the county champ.

**Ottoville, with 3-1 odds, defeated Columbus Grove 35-23 on the boys' side. Columbus Grove, with 15-1 odds, defeated Vaughnsville 17-14 on the girls' side.**
