

Kalida Downs Columbus Grove 106 - 33

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Tuesday night the Wildcats put on an offensive showcase as they downed Columbus Grove 106-33 in Putnam County League action.

The win leaves the Wildcats with a 3-0 league record and 5-0 overall. Columbus Grove slipped to 0-2 in the league and were 1-5 in all games.

The Wildcats offense was in high gear as they opened the game by scoring 36 points in the first quarter. The offense continued to click all night as Kalida never scored below 17 points in any one quarter as they led 53-16 at the break.

While the Kalida offense was running on all cylinders the defense also played well. The Wildcats limited the Bulldogs to single digit

scoring in three of four quarters and forced 43 Grove turnovers. The Bulldogs also took just 35 shots in the game as they connected on 15 of them with one three-pointer. The Wildcats took 79 shots in the game and hit on 40 of them with a three-pointer.

Kalida placed five players in double digits led by Miller with a game high 29 points. Kerri Unverferth chipped in with 19 points, Deb Schroeder had 14 points, Kristen Unverferth had 12 points and Eberle finished with 11.

Miller also had nine steals and seven assists and Kerri Unverferth had 10 rebounds.

For the Bulldogs Jill Duling had seven points and Nikki Ricker pulled in seven rebounds.
