The most points scored by any girls' team in a season was in 1989 when Kalida scored 1,766 points in 27 games and averaged 65 points per game. Ottawa-Glandorf, in 1991, scored 1,634 points and averaged the most points per game with 71 points over 23 games. The most points scored in a game was 106. Kalida accomplished this feat in 1998 against Columbus Grove and Miller City did it against Tinora in 2004.
