# Special Rules for Overtime Games In the P.C. Tournament of 1936 

Rules for the Girls

In girl's overtime games there will be a rest period of three minutes followed by one overtime of three minutes.

If a tie still exists, each player of the competing teams will be allowed one free throw. The team making the most shots will be declared the winner. If this results in a tie, one or more round of free throws will be taken until the winner has been decided.

## Rules for the Boys

In boy's overtime games the first team to score two points in the overtime period or periods is to be declared the winner.

Play should be continued during the first overtime period till one team has scored two points.

If neither team scores two points during the first overtime there should be a five-minute intermission and play should continue during the additional overtimes until a team has scored two points.

This applies even though one team is one point in the lead at the end of the first three minutes.

The game is ended as soon as the two points are scored, whether this is in the first overtime or a succeeding one.

In unusual cases where the second point is scored as a result of a double foul, both free throws are allowed. If the score is tied after the two free throws the game may be won by the scoring of one additional point thereafter.
