The Ottoville coaching staff collected its 100th career coaching win Monday night as the Big Green defeated Ayersville 55-50 in non-league action.

The win Monday was close for the Big Green as they broke out to a first quarter lead and had to hold off the Pilots (9-9).

Both teams scored 14 points in the second quarter before the Pilots posted a 14-12 third quarter scoring advantage. Ottoville held on for the win with a 13-12 fourth quarter scoring margin. Kris Youngpeter led the Big Green with 15 points, six assists and four steals. Nikki Byrne had a real strong game with 12 points and 11 rebounds.
