Deb Wasserman 1978 – 1981 1,146 Points

First Continental Player to Score 1,000 Points

Deb Wasserman started her varsity basketball career as a freshman at Continental High School in 1978 when she scored 52 points.

Continental, 14-6, won a Sectional Championship, but lost to Ottoville in the Districts, 72-41.

In 1979, Deb scored 230 points. She was named 2^{nd} Team All-PCL.

In 1980, She scored 405 points. Deb was named 1st Team All-PCL and Player of the Year.

In 1981, Deb had her best season when she scored 459 points. She was named 1st Team All-PCL for the second time and 1st Team District 8.

For her career, Deb scored 1,146 points. During her tenure, the Pirates were 43-30.

Char Smith – Johnson 1981 – 1984 1,724 Points

CONTINENTAL'S #1 SCORER

Char Smith was one of the greatest female scorers at Continental High School and in Putnam County.

In 1981 as a freshman, Char started off quietly by scoring 213 points.

In 1982, Char doubled her offensive production by scoring 413 points. She was named 1st Team All-PCL and Special Mention All-Oho.

In 1983, she poured in 547 points. Char was now being recognized by the basketball world outside of Putnam County. She was not only named to the 1st Team All-PCL for the second year in a row, but Char also was selected to the 1st Team District 8. The next prestigious award was being named to the 2nd Team All-Ohio by the Associated Press.

In 1984, Char's scoring finally went down. She "ONLY" scored 540 points. She had two incredible games in which she scored 43 points against Hilltop and 42 points against

Pandora-Gilboa. She was named 1st Team All-PCL, PCL Player of the Year, 1st Team District 8 and Player of the Year, 1st Team Northwestern Ohio and 1st Team All-Ohio by the Associated Press. Char was also selected to play in the Ohio/Indiana All-Star game which was at that time called the Nancy Rehm Invitational.

In addition to her individual success, the Continental Pirates won the Putnam County League with a 6-1 record and finished the season at 15-7.

She scored 1,724 points in her four years at Continental.

Following her graduation at Continental in 1984, she went to Ohio Northern University where she earned 12 varsity letters from 1985 – 1988 in volleyball, track and basketball.

In 1988, her senior year, she led Ohio Northern to a 23 - 4 record by scoring 483 points which included 42 points against Otterbein. Char also pulled in 212 rebounds.

ONU won the OAC regular season and tournament title. She was named 1st Team in the Ohio Atlantic Conference and also the All-Atlantic Region.

During her four-year career, Char scored 837 points and grabbed 485 rebounds while leading the team to a 75 - 27 record.

Char was inducted into the Ohio Northern University Hall of Fame in 2000.

Annette Rue – Hoeffel 1992 – 1995 1,132 Points

Annette Rue started her high school basketball career at Continental in 1992 when she scored 233 points.

Continental, 17-7, won a Sectional Championship, but lost to Crestview in the District Finals, 42-36.

In 1993, Annette scored 279 points with 38 rebounds. She was named 1st Team All-PCL.

The Pirates, 16-6, won a PCL and Sectional Championship, but lost to Ottoville in the Districts, 41-39.

In 1994, Annette scored 340 points with 120 rebounds, 100 steals and 80 assists. She was named 1st Team All-PCL and 2nd Team District 8.

In 1995, Annette scored 280 points with 112 rebounds, 70 steals and 40 assists. She was named 1st Team All-PCL, 1st Team District 8 and Honorable Mention Northwestern Ohio.

For her career, Annette scored 1,132 points with 288 rebounds, over 200 steals and over 150 assists.

Following high school, Annette went to Defiance College and played basketball.

Brooke Tegenkamp 2006 – 2009 1,017 Points

Brooke began her varsity basketball career at Continental in 2006 when she scored 112 points with 20 steals and 13 assists.

In 2007, she scored 285 points with 41 steals and 27 assists.

Continental, 16-5, won a Sectional Championship, but lost to Crestview in the Districts, 57-47.

In 2008, Brooke scored 339 points with 50 steals and 54 assists. She was named 2nd Team All-PCL and 2nd Team District 8.

The Pirates, 16-8, won a Sectional and District Championship, but lost to New Riegel in the Regionals, 42-39.

In 2009, she scored 281 points with 72 steals and 74 assists. Brooke was named 1st Team All-PCL, 1st Team District 8 and Honorable Mention All-Ohio.

For her career, Brooke scored 1,017 points with 183 steals and 168 assists. During her tenure, Continental was 55-32.

Paige Ordway 2011 – 2014 753 Points

Paige began her varsity basketball career at Continental in 2011 when she scored 6 points.

In 2012, she scored 129 points with 62 rebounds, 34 steals and 45 assists.

In 2013, Paige scored 229 points with 51 rebounds, 46 steals and 41 assists. She was named 1st Team All-PCL and Special Mention Northwestern Ohio.

In 2014, she scored 389 points with 85 rebounds, 80 steals and 39 assists. Paige was named 1st Team All-PCL, PCL

Player of the Year, 1st Team District 8, 1st Team Northwestern Ohio and Special Mention All-Ohio.

For her career, Paige scored 753 points with 198 rebounds, 160 steals and 125 assists. During her tenure, Continental was 48-41.
