

Coach Yant Wins 300th Game

TOLEDO – Ottawa-Glandorf jumped out to an early lead Saturday afternoon in defeating Toledo Central Catholic 64-23 in non-league action.

The win was the 300th career coaching win for the Titan head coach Troy Yant, who in his 13th season of coaching the team. The top ranked Titans moved to 16-0 on the season, while the Irish dropped to 3-12 for the season.

Ottawa-Glandorf wasted little time in taking the lead outscoring the Irish 20-8 after the first quarter. That early lead was enough as defensively the Titans allowed Central Catholic just 15 points the rest of the game. The Irish were held to just five points in the second half by the Titans defensive pressure.

The Titans had a 42-18 halftime lead after a 22-10 second quarter scoring margin.

Karsyn Erford led the Titans with 15 points, while Carlie Brinkman, Kaelyn Grothause and Kaitlyn Kimmet all added 10 points.

Serenity Bolden led the Irish with seven points.
