

Big Green Captures PCL Golf Title at Delphos CC – Ott's Win 7th Title 1985 PCL Tournament

Ottoville's Big Green captured its seventh Putnam County League golf title Monday at the Delphos Country Club, posting a 331-347 score over runner-up Kalida.

Columbus Grove carded a 349 to finish a close third, followed by Ft. Jennings at 351, Continental at 356 and Miller City at 378.

The Big Green won the meet with a squad dominated by sophomores. Dale Schimmoeller, Ottoville's only junior, carded a 35-42-77 to lead the Big Green. Freshman Greg Kortokrax added a 39-45-85, while sophomores Troy Landin, Brian Miller and Mike Schnipke rounded out the total. Landin carded a 42-43-85, while Miller carded a 40-45-85 and Schnipke carded a 43-43-86.

Monday's victory was the seventh in the PCL golf championship's 11 year history.

Kalida's Grant Williams was the PCL medalist for the second straight year, leading all players with a 35-41-76. He joined Schimmoeller on the All-PCL first team, along with Miller City's Jeff Lammers 40-42-82, Continental's Troy Slattman 42-41-83 and Columbus Grove's Greg Bunn 38-45-83.

The Big Green landed three team members on the All-PCL second team. Joining Kortokrax, Landin and Miller were Columbus Grove's Jason Allen 42-

43-85 and Kalida's Ross Recker 41-43-84.
