

Leipsic High Takes First in County Track Events Held Wednesday

Leipsic high's boys and girls track and field teams took first honors in the county events which were held at Bluffton Wednesday afternoon. The events had been postponed from one week and one day to another because of regular rains and officials finally decided to set Wednesday of this week regardless of conditions of grounds, but downpours Wednesday morning in Ottawa forced the event to go to Bluffton.

In the boys' events Leipsic was high with 80 points; Pandora came in second with 43.5 points, Columbus Grove third with 36, Blanchard fourth with 25 and Ottawa Public 21 ½ points. Kalida failed to gain any points in these events.

In the girls' events, Leipsic had 26.5 points, Blanchard 19.5 and Pandora 16. Cups were awarded the winning schools with medals awarded to individual winners.
