Three Records Broken in Field Events

Putnam County Sentinel – May 7, 1948

The largest crowd ever to attend the Class "B" Putnam County Field and Track Meet, over 800 persons, watched three records broken at Pandora Wednesday and saw Pandora pace off easily with the championship.

R. Diller, Pandora speedster, marked 10.2 in the 100 yard dash, shattering the previous record of 10.4 made in 1928 by Allen from Ottawa.

This was not true. The previous record was held by Jesse Lehman of Pandora. He ran a 100 yard dash in 10.3 in 1921.

Diller again scored with 23.5 in the 220 yard dash to erase the past high of 23.6 made in 1947 by Buddelmeyer of Glandorf.

This was not true. The record was held by C. Pugh of Columbus Grove. Pugh ran a 220 yard dash in 23.3 in 1940.

In the 220 low hurdles, Corkwell of Ottawa, made 27.6. The old record of 28.4 was made in 1940 by Columbus Grove's Pugh.

This was not true. The record was held by C. Pugh of Columbus Grove in 1940. The time, however, was 27.9.

Pandora won the half mile relay, 140.6, to win the Pandora Star lunch trophy. Shelley Radabaugh was the starter and referee.
