

Pandora Triumphs in Track Meet as Two Records Are Set

Two new records were set as Pandora walked off with its fifth straight county track and field meet under the lights at Pandora Wednesday night.

The new records were set by two Leipsic jumpers. Kelly went 9'10½" in the air in the pole vault event for a new mark and Kratzer 5'7¾" for the record in the high jump.

Only one record was set in 1950. Norm Kelly of Leipsic did not set a new record. In 1928, Selwynn Judson of Leipsic crossed the bar at 10'3¾" to set the PCL pole vaulting record. This event was not held from 1929-1944 and may have been the reason why it was overlooked.

Pandora scored 71 points to win first place while Columbus Grove, its nearest opponent, racked up 60. Other scores were Continental 30, Ottawa Public 16, Leipsic 13, Fort Jennings 13, Miller City 5 and Glandorf 2.

Trophies were awarded to Pandora and Columbus Grove. The traveling Pandora Businessmen's trophy went to Continental, winner of the 880 yard relay.
