The boys' 440 yard relay was first held in the PCL Track and Field Meet in 1935 with Ottawa Public winning and setting the initial record at 49.7 seconds. The runners are unknown. This event only ran two years. It was restarted in 1979 with Pandora-Gilboa winning with a record setting time of 48.6 seconds. The runners were Terry Siefer, Gerry Siefer, Jeff Emans and Jeff Diller. In 1988, Pandora-Gilboa set the standard at 44.7 seconds which held up for 15 years. The runners were Nathan Sprunger, Mike Bryan, Greg Grismore and Jeff Goddard. The current record of 44.2 seconds is held by Columbus Grove and was set in 2003. The runners were Blaine Maag, Tayte Mayberry, Trevor Miller and Steve Palte. The event was converted to a comparable length of 400 meters in 1980.
