The boys' mile relay has been held in nearly every PCL Track and Field Meet since 1920. The first relay was won by Ottawa in 1920 with a time of 4 minutes, 27.2 seconds. The runners were Simon, Harris, Purnell and Ridenour. In 1965, Ottawa-Glandorf set the standard at 3 minutes, 35.5 seconds which held up for 35 years. O-G's runners were Bob Jones, Bill Cutlip, Bill Roeder and Jim VanHousen. The current record of 3 minutes, 25.4 seconds is held by Pandora-Gilboa and was set in 2003. The runners were Jon Amstutz, Caleb Arthur, John Nash and Brett Siefker. The event was converted to a comparable length of 1600 meters in 1980.
