The PCL Champion has been determined in one of four ways. One method was to split the league into two divisions and then have a playoff between the two winners. Another way was to split the league into two divisions and then have a playoff between the top two teams in each division. A third method was to play a single elimination tournament. From 1931-1964, the two top teams would advance to the OHSAA State Tournament. A fourth method was to put the members into one division and then determine the champion by the best record. This is the method used today.
