

# Crawfis Nine Defeats Leipsic

Klausing KO's 22 and Pingle KO's 19

Crawfis High School's baseball nine won against Leipsic High Monday afternoon after ten and one-half scoreless innings in a scheduled seven inning game.

Crawfis came to bat in the eleventh inning and with the aid of a hit, a base on balls and an error, brought in the score which netted them a one to nothing win. Omer Pingle fanned nineteen of the Leipsic batters, while Klausing retired twenty-two Crawfis batsmen. Leipsic had three hits to two for Crawfis.
