Miller City was limited to five hits Thursday in a win over Leipsic. Friday afternoon they saw one more ball than that leave the park.

The Wildcats blasted six home runs Friday on their home field as they trounced Wayne trace 17-6 in non-league baseball action.

Miller City's (6-3) home run barrage was led by senior catcher Dusty Pester as he belted three home runs. Mark Burkhart, Craig Otto and Andy Schnipke had one round tripper each Friday.

Pester, who finished with six RBI's, opened his home run hitting as he hit a two run shot as part of a three run first inning. He then added a solo shot in the third inning and

closed out his day with a three run shot in the fourth inning.

Mark Burkhart also had a three run home run in the third inning, as he added two singles and a double to finish with six RBI's.

The home runs helped Otto pick up the win as he went four innings allowing five runs with five strikeouts and two walks. Dominic Inkrott threw an inning allowing a run with a walk.
