

First Time Parochial Hi Wins Trophy

Also Win High Scoring Honors at Tourney

The girl's game was followed by the final game of the county tournament, the outcome to determine the county champions for the season – the contestants Ottawa Parochial and Vaughnsville High. Both teams played cautiously and on the defense.

Vaughnsville opened the scoring with a free point; Ottawa followed with a field goal and Vaughnsville garnered four free baskets in order and Parochial High ended the period with a field shot. The score at quarter time – Vaughnsville five and Ottawa four.

Ottawa tied the score with a free throw at the opening of the second frame, but Vaughnsville again went into the lead with a field shot. Ottawa tied the county on two free throws and took the lead for the first time in the game with a field basket. Vaughnsville again tied the count and took the lead with a foul shot and two field baskets and Ottawa came back with a field basket as the gun ended the first half. Vaughnsville led 12 to 11.

Ottawa came through with two field baskets as the third quarter got under way and took a three-point lead. Vaughnsville tied the count with a field goal and foul shot. Ottawa Parochial took the lead with a foul shot and Vaughnsville tied with a basket from the free circle. Ottawa Parochial made a free basket to take a one-point lead as the quarter ended 17 to 16.

Ottawa Parochial brought their count to 18 with a free shot. Vaughnsville tied the count and took a one-point lead with three free tosses. Ottawa then placed two field shots to take the lead and win the game as Vaughnsville was only able to make another free pass. Ottawa Parochial added another free pass for good measure. The engagement ended with the score 23 to 20 in favor of Ottawa Parochial.
