# All Girls and $7^{\text {th }} / \mathbf{8}^{\text {th }}$ Boys to Use Smaller Basketball

The Board of Control of the Ohio High School Athletic Association adopted a resolution at their meeting on March 21, 1985 which mandates the use of a smaller basketball in girls interscholastic and tournament competition. The smaller ball will be used in all girls' contests, grades $7-12$, and grades $7-8$ boys' effective with the 1985-86 school year.

The ball adopted by the Board of Control is 1 inch smaller and 2 oz . lighter than the regulation sized basketball being used to day.

The measurements are a minimum of $281 / 2 "$ to a maximum of $29 "$ in circumference and a minimum weight of 18 oz . to a maximum of 20 oz .

The above smaller ball has been adopted for use by the National Federation Basketball Rules Committee. This is the same size ball that is being used by college women.
