Kalida's Kortokrax Wins 700th

Kalida didn't need a second chance to get Coach Dick Kortokrax his 700th win.

The Wildcats came out hot as they jumped out to a big lead in beating Sycamore Mohawk 76-40 in non-league boy's basketball action. The win moved Kalida to 6-3 on the season.

Kortokrax got win 699 as the Wildcats downed Wayne Trace one week earlier. With Mohawk up next, the veteran Wildcat boss saw his team perform very well as he collected win number 700. He is the first coach in Ohio High School to have won 700 career games. In December, he became the winningest boy's basketball coach in Ohio.

Kortokrax now owns a 700-242 record in his 43-year coaching career. Now in his 28th season at Kalida, he has posted a 474-152 record. He started his coaching career at Fort Jennings where he posted a 26-18 record in two seasons. He then returned to his high school alma mater Ottoville, and posted a 200-82 record over 13 seasons.

In this game, the Wildcats jumped out to a quick lead and continued to add to it.

Kalida led 17-5 after the opening eight minutes of play and led 58-28 after three quarters as they outscored Mohawk 22-11 in the third quarter.

Cody Maxwell led the Wildcats with a game high 15 points and Ryan Schroeder tossed in 11 points. A total of 12 Kalida players scored in the game.

At the time, it was thought that this was Coach Kortokrax's 700th win during his 43rd season of coaching and 28th at Kalida. The actual 700th win came the next game against Fort Jennings when Kalida won 51-37. The Wildcats were 13-9 in 2003, losing to Crestview in the Sectionals. Dick was named the PCL Coach of the Year in 2000 and 2001 at Kalida for the 8th and 9th time, 14th overall.
