

# **Columbus Grove in First Place**

**Tournament Decided by Five Hot Games**

**Winner Will be Declared the County Champs for the First Time**

**Putnam County Sentinel – February 29, 1924**

Columbus Grove defeated Continental, 24 to 6, to win the first Putnam County tournament for the girls.

In the first round, Ottawa Public knocked off Crawfis College 16 to 3.

Columbus Grove was next with a victory over Leipsic 9 to 4.

In the second round, Continental finished off Vaughnsville 8 to 2.

Columbus Grove then bested Ottawa Public 9 to 3.

In the finals, Columbus Grove defeated Continental 9 to 5 to become the first Putnam County tournament champion.

The girls' tournament was not for advancement in Ohio's sanctioned tournament, but only to determine the best girls' team in Putnam County.
