

# Leipsic Hi Girls Win

## Defeated Continental in Final Contest

The Putnam County basketball season for the girls' teams of the county officially came to a close Tuesday evening when the Leipsic High team walked away with county honors and received the trophy. Leipsic defeated Continental High by a score of 19 to 9.

Here is the way it happened. Rader missed the first foul shot and then caged a counter. Hummon threw one from the floor and Crow added a foul shot. Hazelton of Continental placed a nice field goal to end the quarter.

In the second quarter, Walls missed a couple of free throws as did Pitney. Hummon rung up a fielder as did Hurley of Continental. Hummon caged another two points as the half ended.

At the start of the third quarter, Crow missed a long shot and Rader connected for two points. Hummon shot two baskets and Rader hit a foul. Pitney sunk a couple of fielders to end the third session.

Keeran went in to give Hummon a rest and Rader shot a field goal. Walls connected with a gift shot. Yoakum was put into the game and missed a foul shot. Crow scored from the foul line to end the game.

It was simply a case of superior work on the part of the Leipsic guards who have outplayed their opponents all year through Sweigart, Hummon, Yoakum and Dick. They have never been equaled as a combination in the defensive territory.
