The 1991 Putnam County League golf championships were a near carbon copy of the 1990 championships.

Kalida won the 1990 championship by eight strokes. In 1991 they won by eight strokes.

In 1990 Ottoville finished in the runner-up spot. In 1991 Miller City took runner-up honors as the battle for the top spot came down to the final three-some.

Kalida shot a 336 team total to Miller City's 344 total. Third was Ottoville with a 353, followed by Fort Jennings at 367, Continental at 386, Pandora-Gilboa at 409 and Columbus Grove at 424. It was the third straight year the Wildcats of Kalida have won the PCL title.

Strong winds and a somewhat hard golf course greeted the young county golfers at Pike Run. However, three young golfers didn't seem to let the conditions bother them just too much.

Kalida sophomore Andy Williams captured medalist honors as he shot a 76 (38-38). His round was very steady as he had three birdies, three bogeys and two double bogeys for his 4-over par score.

In the runner-up position was Williams's teammate, junior Amy Langhals, and Miller City senior Randy Siefker, as both golfers shot an 81. Ironically Siefker and Williams were the only golfers to break 40 on Monday as Williams had his pair of 38's and Siefker carded a front nine score of 39.

Williams, Langhals and Siefker all gained first team PCL honors. They were joined by Ottoville's Kurt Hilvers, Fort Jennings Brad Vetter, Miller City's Andy Layne and Ottoville's Mike Hilvers.

On the second team were Kevin Morman and Joe Schroeder of Miller City, Troy Rampe of Kalida, Mark Schnipke of Ottoville and Stacy Hermiller of Pandora-Gilboa.

While Williams shot a 76 and Langhals an 81 for Kalida they were helped by Troy Rampe at 89 and John Heckman with a 90. Ryan Turnwald was their fifth man with a score of 97.

After Siefker's 81 for Miller City, Andy Layne carded an 87, Kevin Morman and Joe Schroeder an 88 and Mike Rosengarten had a 90.

Ottoville was led by Kurt Hilvers with an 85, Matt Hilvers followed with an 87, Mark Schnipke had an 89, Joe Niedecken 92 and Jason Metcalfe a 95.

Ft. Jennings saw Brad Vetter lead the way with an 87 followed by Nate Schroeder with a 91, Eric Schroeder had a 93, Ryan VonSossan a 96 and Kevin Grone a 100.

Continental took the fifth spot with a Chad Fuller leading the way at 93, Dan Wagner was next with a 95,

Chad Adkins and Travis Porter had 99's and Jon Tobias had a 105.

The Rockets of P-G were led by senior Stacy Hermiller with an 89. Jason Stokes followed with a 105, Josh Huffman had a 107, Andy Hovest had a 108 and Andy Green a 120.

A very young Columbus Grove team took the last spot available as they were led by Neil Schaublin with a 98, Mike Meffley had a 105, Brian Kirst a 109, Ryan Kruse and 112 and Matt Bolyard a 120.
