

Pandora-Gilboa Halts Grove's Track Reign

Putnam County Sentinel – May 17, 1957

Pandora-Gilboa thincclads Monday afternoon snapped Columbus Grove's six-year domination of the Putnam County Track and Filed Meet, winning the six-team event with 91.5 points.

The meet, originally scheduled for Friday afternoon, was postponed due to rain and the final event of Monday's meet, the mile relay, was run in rain.

Only one record was set in the meet when Dave Wenger of Pandora ran the half mile in 2:05.6 to better a 10-year-old mark of 2:09.5 set in 1947 by J. Diller, also of Pandora.

Columbus Grove finished second in the meet with 66 points. Leipsic scored 27.5, Continental 22.5, Glandorf 9.5 and Ottawa Public 6. The other six schools in the county did not participate.

The Rockets dominated all field events, winning all five. They also won three of the seven track events, while Grove and Leipsic won two each and Continental one.

Pandora's Ron Knepper was the individual star, winning the high and broad jumps, the 180 yard low hurdles and was a member of the winning half mile relay team.

Pandora-Gilboa's victory was the fifth for that school in the past 11 meets. Before Grove began its six-year reign in 1951, Pandora had won the event four straight times between 1947 and 1950.
