The boys' two mile run has been held in every PCL Track and Field Meet since 1966. The first run and record was held by Keith Hohenbrink of Ottawa-Glandorf when he ran the event in 10 minutes, 23.3 seconds. In 1977, Brent Devitt of Ottoville, set the standard at 10 minutes, 2.0 seconds, which held up for 10 years. In 1988, Mondo Tijerina of Columbus Grove ran the event at 9 minutes, 57.1 seconds and held the record for 24 years. In 2012, Jake Graham of Columbus Grove broke that record with a run of 9 minutes, 51.7 seconds. He reset the record again in 2013 with a time 9 minutes, 39.9 seconds. The current record was set in 2023 by Luke Ellerbrock of Columbus Grove who ran it in 9:24.74. The event was converted to a comparable length of 3,200 meters in 1980.
