CG Sweeps PCL Varsity Track Championship

Columbus Grove's track teams took different routes to Putnam County League titles Friday night. The girls used their depth as they won just four events but had four second place showings and nine double placements to win the title.

The Bulldogs narrowly defeated Fort Jennings 138-123. Defending PCL Champion Ottoville was third with 106 points, while P-G was fourth with 63 points, Leipsic was fifth with 48 and Continental was sixth with 30 points.

Freshman Sydney McCluer was a double winner for the Bulldogs taking both hurdle events as she won the 100's in 16.0 and the 300's in 48.8. Sarah Schroeder, Nicole Langhals, Jessi Smith and Brooke Brubaker won the 400 relay in 53.2 and Megan Verhoff won the discus with a throw of 125'0", which was a personal best for her.

Junior Macy Schroeder kept the Lady Musketeers close as she had a hand in four of the six wins for Fort Jennings.

Schroeder won the 100 (12.5), 200 (26.6) and 400 (1:01.7), while teaming with Stephanie Korte. Kaitlin Stechschulte and Lori Bruskotter to win the 800 relay (1:49.1). The Lady Musketeers went one-two in the 100 and 200 with Bruskotter taking second in both events. Stechschulte won the 800 (2:30.4) and Marissa Stechschulte. Mesker. Brittany Inkrott and Korte combined to win the 3200 relay (10:56.4).

Ottoville finished with over 100 points as they won four events led by sophomore Tonya Kaufman who won the high jump (5'3") and long jump (16'7³/4"). Lauren Kramer won the shot (37'4"), while Taylor Mangas, Kaufman, Abby Siefker and Monica Sarka won the 1600 relay (4:21.2).

Sophomore Vanessa McCullough won the 1600 (5:43.9) and 3200 (12:53.0) meter runs and senior Ellie Braidic won the pole vault clearing 12'7", which was an inch higher than her seed height coming in.
