In 1920, Cecil Hickerson of Leipsic won the baseball throw, establishing the PCL Track and Field Meet record with a throw of 127'5.5". In 1929, Leona Miller of Pandora, set the standard at 215'6". This event was retired in 1942 with Miller still holding the record.
