History of Player Selection from 1951 to the Present

From 1925 to 1950, the All Putnam County League or Putnam County League Tournament Teams were selected in many different ways. In some years, someone from one of the many local newspapers such as the Putnam County Sentinel, the Leipsic Free Press or the Continental News-Review would select teams. In some years the coaches would select a team. In 1951, a format similar to the one used today was started. There are several teams during this period that are missing. From 1958 to the present, the varsity coach of each PCL school selects the players and coaches for a 1st Team, a 2nd Team, a Player of the Year and a Coach of the Year.
